

LAC DU FLAMBEAU TRANSFER STATION RESIDENTS

This is how you will have to prepare your household garbage and recyclables.

GLASS, PLASTIC, CARDBOARD, NEWSPAPER, MAGAZINES, OFFICE PAPER & TIN is now considered mixed (Commingled) trash. **THE GLASS** had to have come from **FOOD & DRINK CONTAINERS** only. **THE PLASTIC** had to come from **MILK, SODA, WATER, JUICE, CLEANERS, & LIQUOR**. **THE TIN AND STEEL** must be from **FOOD AND PET FOOD CONTAINERS** only. Please rinse out all containers.

THE FOLLOWING ARE REGULAR TRASH ITEMS:

GLASS: items like dishes, regular light bulbs, food/drink bottles, plates & cups, etc.

PLASTICS: items like oil, anti-freeze, paint solvents, containers from the deli, styro-foam, plastic film, milk, soda, juice, water, cleaners, liquor and plastic bags.

TIN: items like cardboard sided cans, fuel cans, aerosol cans, food and pet food cans.

MIXED PAPER: ledger covers, hard backed covers, newspaper, magazines and office/computer paper.

ALUMINUM FOIL AND ALUMINUM FOOD CONTAINERS: deli food containers, foil covers and aluminum pie pans.

ALUMINUM POP & BEER CANS are accepted as is. **PLEASE DO NOT MIX WITH OTHER RECYCABLES.**

CORRUGATED BOXES, BROWN PAPER BAGS, KLEENEX, FOOD & CEREAL BOXES, TOILET & PAPER TOWEL TUBES, POP AND BEER CASES & PET FOOD BAGS that do not have plastic inserts can go into the **CARDBOARD CONTAINER**.

ALL REGULAR HOUSEHOLD GARBAGE MUST BE IN A TRANSPARENT BAG. It shouldn't contain any recyclable items. **THERE IS A CHARGE OF \$2.00** for a kitchen size (**UP TO 16 GAL.**) & **\$4.00** for a larger bag (**UP TO 32 GAL.**).

THE METAL CONTAINER: Refrigerators, freezers, hot water tanks, lawn mowers, bed springs, washers, dryers & most scrap metals, such as empty and dry paint cans are some of the metals that will be accepted, **FOR A FEE.**

THE FURNITURE CONTAINER: Couches, chairs, mattresses & carpeting are some of the items we will accept **FOR A FEE.**

CLOTHING/CLOTH ITEMS: Where clothing goes will be up to the discretion of the attendant with the same fee as garbage.

Items such as plastic flower containers, small plastic toys, Styrofoam & plastic buckets go into regular household garbage.

WE NOW ACCEPT: florescent bulbs, all batteries, ballasts, brush, up to 4" in diameter, leaves, grass clippings & pine needles at no charge.

WE WILL NOT ACCEPT

Motor oil, car parts, herbicides, paint, medications, used syringes, hazardous waste & demolition waste such as concrete, bricks, blocks, any lumber, plywood, drywall, porcelain, etc.

THE TRANSFER STATION IS OPENED ON FRI, SAT, SUN, & MON FROM 9:00 AM TO 4:00 PM. THE PHONE NUMBER IS 715-588-3696
