ORDINANCE NO. 94-02D

DESIGNATING TOWN ROAD HIGHWAYS AS SNOWMOBILE ROUTES

- 1.01 **TITLE:** Ordinance designating town road highways as snowmobile routes.
- 1.02 **STATUTORY AUTHORITY:** This Ordinance is adopted as authorized under Sec. 350.047, Wis. Stats.
- 1.03 **PURPOSE:** The purpose of this Ordinance is to help ensure the safety of those persons operating snowmobiles within the Town of Lac Du Flambeau, as well as other vehicular travelers and pedestrians.
- 1.04 **STATE SNOWMOBILE REGULATIONS ADOPTED BY REFERENCE:** State regulations regarding the operation of snowmobiles as found in Sec. 350.01 through 350.99, Wis. Stats. are hereby adopted by reference.
- 1.05 **ABROGATION AND GREATER RESTRICTIONS:** It is not intended by this Ordinance to repeal, abrogate, annul, impair or interfere with any existing rules, regulations, ordinances or permits previously adopted or issued pursuant to law. However, whenever this Ordinance imposes greater restrictions, the provisions of this Ordinance apply.
- 1.06 **INTERPRETATION:** In their interpretation and application, the provisions of this Ordinance shall be held to be minimum requirements and shall not be deemed a limitation or repeal of any other power granted by the Wisconsin Statutes.
- 1.07 **SEVERABILITY:** Should any portion of this Ordinance be declared unconstitutional or invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, the remainder of this Ordinance shall not be affected.
- 1.08 **APPLICABILITY:** The provisions of this Ordinance shall apply to the town roads and/or highways specifically set forth in the following sections of this Ordinance.

2.01 **LIMITATIONS:** This Ordinance designates specific roads and/or highways as snowmobile routes subject to the following limitations:

- a. Snowmobiles shall be operated on the extreme right side of the roadway.
- b. Left turns shall be made as safely as possible from any position depending on snow cover and other prevailing conditions.
- c. Snowmobile operators shall yield right-of-way to other vehicular traffic and pedestrians.
- d. Highways designated for snowmobile operation shall be marked in accordance with Sec. 350.13, Wis. Stats.
- e. Snowmobile operation is not permitted on state truck highways or connecting highways.

3.01 **DESIGNATED ROADS AND/OR HIGHWAYS:** No person shall operate a snowmobile on a town roadway other than the following:



4.01 **ENFORCEMENT:** This Ordinance shall be enforced by any authorized law enforcement officer of the Town of Lac du Flambeau, or any other designated authorized law enforcement officer, including Department of Natural Resources Warden and Vilas County Sheriff's Deputies.


- a. **Penalty:** Any person who violates any of the provisions of this Ordinance shall be subject to a forfeiture of not less than \$50.00 nor more than \$250.00 for each violation plus the cost of prosecution.
- b. **Jurisdiction:** Jurisdiction is hereby conferred upon the Vilas County Circuit Court, Eagle River, Wisconsin, over matters related to violation of this Ordinance.
- c. **Injunction:** Any use or action which violates the provisions of this Ordinance shall be subject to a court injunction prohibiting such violation.

5.01 **EFFECTIVE DATE:** This Ordinance shall become effective upon passage and the day after publication of the notice of adoption.


