The Agenda was approved as presented by voice vote following a motion to approve by John Bartosz and second by Rob Milburn.

Minutes of the April 20th meeting were approved as presented by voice vote following a motion to approve by Donna Roche and second by Dennis Gathmann.

There were no comments from the public.

Treasurer Milburn presented the Financial Report. The WDNR approved grant funds for 2011 the monies from Manitowish Waters have arrived. TLC expenditures and encumbrances should be reported to the treasurer. The Donation Report will be provided at the June meeting.

Presentation of Action team Reports

Watercraft Inspection Action Team Report. Discussion focused on team members contacting volunteers to inspect watercraft. John Bartosz volunteered to serve as the liaison between the TLC and the White Sand Lake Association regarding watercraft inspections.

Lake Monitoring Action Team Report. A statement was made that the team would meet after the TLC meeting.

Public Relations Action Team Report. PRAT met twice since the previous TLC meeting. All items in storage have been checked. TLC members were issued bundles of literature to be distributed to local businesses. A press release will be issued regarding Clean Boats Clean Waters. A Watercraft Inspection Workshop will be presented at the LdF Town Hall on June 1 and Lakes Fest is scheduled for June 25. A newsletter is in progress and volunteers are needed to seal and stamp the newsletters.

Lake Steward Action Team Report. Plans for the workshop are on schedule.

Lake Association Action Team Report. The team will meet after the roundtable scheduled for lake association presidents is held.

Purple Loosestrife Action Team Report. About 200 plants have been potted. Members will meet Friday morning to complete netting. Several hundred beetles will arrive from Brock Woods soon.

Planning Action Team Report. A list of fines for AIS violations was distributed. Gretchen Watkins will check on the fines applicability on the Reservation.

Regarding the Tribal Report, Gretchen Watkins mentioned Chapter 40 and how it relates to tribal members. Natural Resource Game Wardens have been cross-deputized. Improvements have been made to the boat landing on Fence

Lake. Other landings will follow. The improvements include expanded paved parking areas. The Lakes Clean-up Sweep will be held on June 10 at the Casino (rain date is June 13). Like last year, it will begin at 8:00 am. A pot-luck lunch will be at 1:00 pm. \$10 free play tickets will be handed out to volunteers who assist with the lake clean-up. The after-school program went well this year.

No letters or communications were reported.

The meeting scheduled for June 15, 2011 at 10:00 am in the LdF Town Hall was confirmed.

The meeting was adjourned at 11:20 am by voice vote following a motion to adjourn by Rob Milburn and second by Roberta Gast.
