

November 25, 2013 Special Town Board Meeting

The special meeting of the Town Board was called to order by Chairman Gaulke at 10 a.m. Supervisors Ginger Schwanebeck, Bryan Hoover, Treasurer Irene Messinger, and Clerk Nancy Edwards were present.

Others present: Jim Sommerfeldt, Larry Ouimette, Ron Grams, Brian Gauthier.

This meeting was properly posted and the media notified as required by law.

Motion by Mrs. Schwanebeck, and seconded by Mr. Hoover to approve the agenda. The motion carried.

Broadband Survey: A request for a survey to be put onto the back of the tax letter was requested by Mr. Sommerfeldt. The questions were put together by Joni Theobald, Mr. Hoover, and Mr. Sommerfeldt and brought to the board for approval before a final decision was made. A copy of the questions will be attached as part of the record. Mrs. Schwanebeck made two revisions to the questions submitted and they were reviewed and accepted. Mr. Ouimette from the Lac du Flambeau School spoke stating the need for high-speed internet is greatly needed to help students after school hours at home. Many of the students do not currently have access. Mr. Gauthier from the chamber also expressed that he has received many requests from out of town visitors for the need of internet access. Mrs. Messinger reported that the additional cost for the printing of this survey would be approximately \$35.00. The town will pay for this printing. The surveys will be returned to the town hall and the information will be compiled by the Ogema Communications Company that is currently working with the tribe. Motion by Mr. Hoover seconded by Mrs. Schwanebeck to approve the questions and the mailing of the survey with the tax letter. Motion carried.

Sale of Plow Shoes: Mr. Gaulke stated that we had new wheels put on our plow truck and currently we have the old plow shoes available and were approached if we would be willing to sell them. Pete Kolzow from the road crew stated a fair price would be about \$350.00. Motion by Mrs. Schwanebeck seconded by Mr. Hoover to approve the sale of the shoes. Motion carried.

A motion was made by Mrs. Schwanebeck and seconded by Mr. Hoover to adjourn at 10:10 a.m. Carried.
