

May 20, 2015 Regular Town Board Meeting

The regular meeting of the Town Board was called to order by Chairman Gaulke at 1:00 p.m. Supervisors Chris Mayer, Ginger Schwanebeck, Treasurer Irene Messinger and Clerk Nancy Edwards were present. Others present: Roberta Gast, Michael Strasburg Lakeland Times, Norm Wetzel, Jim Sommerfeldt, Chuck and Peg Schaus, Dedie Hanson, Bob Hanson, John Spellmeyer, Gracie Vickerstaff, Don and Francie Hart, Bryon and Julee Radtke, Kay and Mell Hoff, Mike Fraboni, Colette Welch, Tom Wegner, Bryan Hoover, Dee Ann Allen.

This meeting was properly posted and the media notified as required by law.

Motion by Mr. Mayer and seconded by Mrs. Schwanebeck to approve the agenda. The motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Mayer and seconded by Mrs. Schwanebeck to approve voucher numbers 47737-47769 from the General Fund account. Motion carried.

The minutes of the May 6, 2015 Town Board meeting were presented for approval. Motion by Mr. Mayer seconded by Mrs. Schwanebeck to approve the minutes as presented. Motion carried.

Treasurer Messinger provided her report on the financial status as follows: Un-reconciled balance of the General fund as of 05/15/2015 as \$853,245.58. Un-reconciled balance of the Ambulance Fund as of 05/15/2015 as \$393,391.23. Mrs. Messinger reported that the transfer station receipts are increasing. We also received payment from the WDNR for MFL withdrawal tax. Motion by Mr. Mayer seconded by Mrs. Schwanebeck to accept the treasurer's report as presented. Motion carried.

Second Reading and Adoption of Ordinance 15-01- All Terrain Vehicle (ATV) and Utility Terrain Vehicle (UTV) Route Ordinance. Mr. Gaulke asked if there were any comments. A letter was received today from the Lac du Flambeau Band of Lake Superior Chippewa Indians opposing the proposed ATV route within the boundaries of the reservation. A letter was received from Robert Hanson opposing the ordinance. A petition signed by 81 residents was also received opposing the ordinance. Discussion was heard again on the route map, county roads, signage, safety and liability issues, enforcement authority, speed limits, invasive species. Motion by Mr. Mayer for approval of the final reading and adoption of ordinance 2015-01- Town of Lac du Flambeau All-Terrain Vehicle (ATV) and Utility Terrain Vehicle (UTV) route ordinance. Motion seconded by Mrs. Schwanebeck. Motion carried.

Speed limit County D North: Request from Mr. Schaus to have the board write a letter to Vilas County asking them to consider reducing the speed limit on County D going north at the curvy spots. There is a lot of pedestrian traffic on that stretch of the highway. Motion by Mrs. Schwanebeck seconded by Mr. Mayer to have the chairman write a letter to Vilas County asking for the speed to be reduced. Motion Carried.

Speed limit Moss Lake Dr: Mr. Gaulke stated at our last meeting a resident on Moss Lake had a concern regarding the speed limit on Moss Lake Dr. Mr. Gaulke suggested that we put up 35 mph. advisory signs as we did on Thorofare Road. Motion by Mr. Mayer seconded by Mrs. Schwanebeck to have 35 mph. advisory

signs posted on Moss Lake Dr. Motion carried.

Bruesehoff and Huber 3 lot subdivision: Request was brought before the board for approval of a 3 lot subdivision at 1419 Miterwald Lane. This request was brought before the zoning committee and was recommended for approval by the town board. Motion by Mr. Mayer seconded by Mrs. Schwanebeck to approve the 3 lot subdivision as requested. Motion carried.

Eichendorf 3 lot subdivision: Request was brought before the board for approval of a 3 lot subdivision at 2443 E. Plummer Lake Lane. This request was brought before the zoning committee and was recommended for approval by the town board. Motion by Mrs. Schwanebeck seconded by Mr. Mayer to approve the 3 lot subdivision as requested. Motion carried.

Bartenders License Applications for approval: Bartenders applications were received from Barbara J. Kollath, Kara Schurman, Jacqueline Tomasello. Motion by Mrs. Schwanebeck seconded by Mr. Mayer to approve the applications as presented. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Mayer seconded by Mrs. Schwanebeck to adjourn at 2:10 p.m. Motion carried.
